MISSION STATEMENT

New Life Christian Academy exists to educate, equip, and encourage children to become a fully-devoted follower of Christ.

PURPOSE

It is the purpose of New Life Christian Academy (NLCA) to provide a sound, high quality academic program within a Christian environment. This objective is achieved through constant emphasis, which builds on the fundamentals of reading, writing, spelling, arithmetic, science and history. Added emphasis is given to proper development of social behavior and manners.

In addition, the academy’s purpose is to ensure that the salvation message, per the Gospel of Jesus Christ, is clearly and truthfully presented to each student and that each child has an opportunity to give their heart and life to Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior.

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

The ideals of NLCA are to provide students with a high quality Christian education based upon Biblical values and principles.

We believe a student’s education must be more than knowledge of academics. It must include a firm basis for moral conduct, which will strengthen the student’s ideals and responsibilities throughout life. Therefore, teaching children how to stand as strong soldiers of the Lord is central in all NLCA’s teachings, both in the classroom and on the playground.

TEACHING

New Life Christian Academy teaches from a traditional and Christian perspective. The curriculum is well balanced and includes a daily Bible lesson, weekly chapel services, music, art, and physical education.

NLCA provides sound curriculum and applied skills in a sequential order that is developmentally appropriate. Learning takes place through accountability, relationships, motivation, goal setting, and a caring environment that stimulates learning.

Curriculum selected presents appropriate subject matter for students to develop the skills necessary to progress and become proficient in all subject matters. Materials are taught in a manner suggested by ABEKA, which is created to help students learn, memorize and retain material.

NLCA teachers are responsible for recognizing their student’s academic strengths and weaknesses, for understanding a student’s unique characteristics and the way in which they learn, and for implementing a variety of techniques that will help meet the student’s individual needs. NLCA teachers are expected to demonstrate warm, fair, considerate, and respectful behavior toward all students. They are to encourage and teach students academically, socially, and spiritually by modeling moral maturity and characteristics of Christ through personal relationships not only with students, but also with parents.

PARENT-TEACHER CONTACT

Parents are encouraged to write a note to the teacher or call the school office to arrange a conference as soon as a need arises. Parents may not interrupt a class during school hours, but they may go through the school office to contact a student or teacher. Parent observation in the classroom is welcomed but must be cleared through the office.

VOLUNTEERS/VISITORS

Parents are welcome to visit or volunteer in the classroom. Please check in the office before going to the classroom or other locations on campus. You will need to sign in and you will be issued a Visitor Badge to be worn while on campus.

DRESS STANDARDS**UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS** Monday -Thursday

- ◆ **Polo Shirts**---Red, white and navy blue (American flag colors)
- ◆ **Pants, Skorts, Shorts and Skirts**---Navy blue, black and khaki (*Shorts and skorts must be no shorter than three inches above the knee*) ***Form-fitting clothing is not allowed at any time!***
- ◆ **Shoes**---All shoes must be closed-toe with the heel covered. Rubber soles are recommended.
- ◆ **Socks, Tights, and Leggings**---Red, white, navy blue, or black
- ◆ **Hair**---Girls and boys must keep their hair cut and styled neatly. Hair styles that cause a distraction are not allowed. Boy's hair must not be touching their shirt collar. No dyed hair allowed. Faux Hawk is a hairstyle that is allowed for boys, which is a section of hair running from the front to the back of the head, but cannot be more than 1 inch in length. The sides or the back of the head cannot be shaved.
- ◆ **Accessories**---nail polish, pictures and writing on backpacks, lunch pail, sweaters, sweat-shirts, pencils, hair accessories etc. must be in good taste and non-offensive. Tattoos of any kind, monsters, skulls and cross bones, anything gothic in nature, gang related, drugs, tobacco, alcohol etc. are not allowed.
- ◆ **Girls Make-up**---clear lip gloss or chap stick only
- ◆ **Girls Jewelry**---for safety reasons, girls may wear post earrings only. All other jewelry may be worn in moderation, if it is deemed safe and not a distraction. Boys are not allowed to wear earrings. No other piercings are allowed for boys or girls.
- ◆ **Undershirts**---in school colors only (red, white, and navy blue)
- ◆ **Uniforms must be purchased in the uniform section of department stores.**
- ◆ **Field Trips**---Students can wear black or blue jeans and their Spirit shirt (available for purchase in the school office.)

SCHOOL SPIRIT DAY REQUIREMENTS Friday

Students can wear black or blue jean pants or shorts and a shirt with NLCA logos, which may be purchased in the office (otherwise, school uniforms are required). Jean pants and shorts must be in good repair (fraying and holes are not allowed). ***Form-fitting clothing is not allowed at any time!***

Dress Standard Enforcement - Students who are out of dress standards will be sent to the office to change into loaner clothes. The Principal will decide if the student is following dress standards.

DAYCARE INFORMATION

Daycare is provided Monday-Friday from 6:30–7:45 a.m. and 3:15–6:30 p.m. Opportunity is provided for supervised homework and free time. Charges in the afternoon begin 15 minutes after school is dismissed. Students must be properly signed-in and signed-out, with the parent/guardian's signature and time. If students are not properly signed-in or out, they will be charged for the full a.m. or p.m. daycare amount, plus an additional \$5 fee per incident. Payments are due upon receipt.

All NLCA school rules, standards, and conduct as stated in the Student Handbook apply during Daycare. Discipline and consequences will also be enforced per NLCA's Student Handbook.

PAYMENT BOXES

Tuition payments, daycare payments, and misc. payments may be placed in the drop boxes located in the office, teachers' lounge, and preschool room.

EMERGENCY INFORMATION

It is necessary that we have current emergency information in your child's file. It is the parents'/guardians' responsibility to notify the office of any changes.

RELEASE OF STUDENTS

Students will only be released to persons authorized to take students from the school campus as listed on the registration form. If an emergency arises, please contact the school office with the necessary details of the person taking your child from the campus. When taking your child during the school day, the parent or authorized person will need to come to the office first and sign the child out. Students will not be released from the classroom during the day unless they have been signed out from the office.

LUNCHES

When students bring a sack lunch we encourage you to send healthy snacks and lunch with your child as this will help them in the learning environment. *(Please note: Soda and candy is not allowed on campus.)*

Before the beginning of each month a monthly menu will be on the Gradelink calendar. *Pre-orders will not be required.* Instead, Lunch Cards are available for purchase in the office for: \$20 for 5 lunches, \$40 for 10 lunches, \$60 for 15 lunches, or \$80 for 20 lunches.

When your child comes to school, the teacher will take a count for those purchasing lunch that day. Their Lunch Card will be marked to show that they purchased lunch for that day. As a parent, you will need to keep purchasing a new Lunch Card as your child's Lunch Card gets low. If your child shows up at school needing lunch and there aren't any available lunches on his/her Lunch Card, then a new 5-Meal Lunch Card will be started, and you will be billed \$20. At the beginning of the school year, all parents are encouraged to purchase a minimum \$20 Lunch Card for their child to have available. **Daily lunches must be ordered by 9:00 am. After 9:00 am, students may be subject to an emergency lunch which may consist of a peanut butter and jelly sandwich. The cost of an emergency lunch is \$5.00.**

On minimum days, lunch will not be served. Students must bring their own lunch if they are planning on attending daycare.

SNACKS

For children in Kindergarten-6th grade, snacks are available for purchase at recess for 50 cents to \$1.00.

*PAST DUE ACCOUNTS

A late fee of \$25.00 will be charged to your account after the 10th of each month if you have not paid the full tuition. If you have more than one child attending NLCA, a total of \$50 will be charged to your account. **When a tuition account is not paid within the month it is due, students may not be allowed to attend classes beginning the first day of the following month.**

*All accounts **must** be current to receive the student's report card.

*All accounts **must** remain current to re-enroll for the following school year.

*All accounts **must** be current for your child to receive on-campus tutoring.

REFER A FRIEND PROGRAM

For every newly enrolled student you refer to NLCA during the first semester, your child will receive a \$200 discount off their June's account balance. For every newly enrolled student you refer in the second semester, your child will receive a \$100 discount off their June's account balance.

WITHDRAWAL

If for some unforeseen reason, you have to withdraw your child from school, a withdraw form must be completed 30 days prior to withdrawal date. Your child will be billed for each month that child is enrolled at school. If you withdrawal your child from school, or your child is expelled, there is an early withdraw fee of \$50.
